

PARACORD KEYCHAIN

1. Fuse the scarlet and gray paracord together by making a clean cut across the ends of the paracord. If the inner white thread is frayed, cut it or tuck it back in by running your fingers along the length of the cord. Heat both ends with a lighter until you see it start to melt. Do not let it start to burn. Carefully hold the melted ends together for several seconds until they cool and melt together. Roll the fused cord together between your fingers for a cleaner look. Your fused cord should be ~3 feet long.
2. Attach the paracord to the key ring. Make the loop as long as you want the keychain to be, minus a .5-inch loop at the end.
3. Lay the first piece of paracord horizontally across the two pieces of paracord. This will be your center color.
4. Bring the second piece of paracord over the top of the first piece, around the back, and through the hole made by the first piece. Pull tight.
5. Continue by laying the first piece of paracord across, bringing the second piece of paracord over the top, around the back of the keychain, and up through the hole. Pull tight.
6. Repeat.
7. Once you are about an .5 inch from the end, cut and melt the ends. Cut the ends as close to the paracord as possible.
