

GLASS STONE MAGNETS

1. Select your design! You can use the provided Ohio State designs. You can also experiment with scrapbook paper, drawings, magazines, or stickers!
2. Trace the stone on your background paper or use the line on the pre-printed design. Cut the paper to size.
3. Apply a thin layer of Mod Podge to the flat surface of your stone using the foam brush. Place your image on the glue, allowing the image to show through the stone. If needed, use additional Mod Podge to help secure the edges. Let dry.
4. Apply the adhesive side of the magnet to the back of your stone. Use a hot glue gun for an extra strong hold.

Don't have Mod Podge?

Mix white craft glue and water – slowly add water until it becomes the desired consistency.
