- To reach the Scarlet, Gray, or Carmen tiers, a variety of category I events is required. For instance, to meet the Gray tier, three different types of category I events are required, out of the nine. When hosting a series of the same type of event, such as a networking series, the entire series only counts as one type of category I when measuring the club/society level.
- For an event to qualify for reimbursement, the group must be a Scarlet or Gray tier group, they must have remaining eligible reimbursements, they must request an OSUAA communication, and at least 25 people must have been in attendance.
- Scarlet groups can get reimbursed for up to five Category 1 events per year. Gray groups can get reimbursed for up to three Category 1 events per year. Carmen groups must host 1 event per year. If they do not, they have two years before being qualified as an inactive group.
- All clubs must host a game day event and at least 2 board meetings on an annual basis.
