Day 1 | In transit

Depart gateway city for Barcelona, Spain.

Day 2 | Barcelona, Spain

Arrive, transfer and check in to the Renaissance Barcelona Hotel.

Enrichment: Barcelona, Catalonia's Capital.

This evening, meet and mingle with your fellow travelers at a welcome reception in the hotel.

Day 3 | Barcelona

Barcelona's Gothic Quarter. Enjoy a guided walk in the narrow, cobblestone labyrinth of the Barri Gòtic. Begin at the 13th-century Gothic Barcelona Cathedral, with its majestic spires, cloisters and gargoyles. Stroll along the Carrer del Bisbe, with remnants of the Roman Barcino walls, dating to the 1st century B.C. Pass by the famous neo-Gothic Bishop's Bridge to the historic Plaça del Rei, an ode to Catalonia's royal, historic past. Admire the Royal Palace, the five-story medieval watchtower of King Martin and 14th-century Chapel of Saint Agatha.

Demonstration with Lunch. Join an interactive cooking demonstration to delve into Catalan gastronomy. As the chef prepares dishes, learn about the traditions of Catalan cuisine and then savor the authentic dishes for lunch today.

Free Time: The rest of the day and evening are at your leisure to explore Barcelona.

Day 4 | Barcelona

Enrichment: Barcelona Today.

Montjuïc Hill & the Waterfront. Drive up to Montjuïc hill to marvel at panoramic views

of the city and the Mediterranean Sea. Pass by the Christopher Columbus monument, a symbol of Barcelona; the World Trade Center, shaped like a ship; and the medieval, royal Drassanes shipyards. Continue down to the waterfront, a stunning fusion of palm-lined promenades, golden beaches, super-yachts and quintessential Mediterranean charm.

Have lunch together at a local restaurant.

Free Time: Enjoy the rest of the afternoon and evening, including dinner, at leisure.

Day 5 | Barcelona

Enrichment: Catalan Modernism & Gaudí. **Free Time:** After the lecture, relish the morning at leisure and enjoy lunch on your own.

La Sagrada Familía. Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí was one of the most influential figures of the Catalan modernist art nouveau movement, instrumental in defining Barcelona's majestic architectural landscape. Today, visit the iconic Basílica de la Sagrada Familía, a masterpiece of architectural innovation and Gaudí's most monumental work. Marvel at the basilica's 18 towering spires and three starkly contrasting façades depicting the birth, death and glory of Christ. In the stunning interior, admire the tall, branching columns that evoke a forest canopy; the circular altar with a mosaic of Christ: the nave's soaring arches of delicate stonework; and the vibrant stained-glass windows, creating a stunning kaleidoscope of color and light.

Hospital de Sant Pau. Visit the extraordinary art nouveau campus of the former Hospital de Sant Pau. Built between 1901 and 1930, this masterpiece of Catalan modernist architecture



is regarded for its exquisite sensitivity to design and singular beauty, featuring vibrant mosaics, ornamental façades and lush, serene gardens. Return to the hotel and relish dinner together.

Day 6 | Barcelona

Museu Picasso & El Born. Enjoy a private tour of the Picasso Museum, holding more than 4,200 of Pablo Picasso's paintings, drawings, sculptures and ceramics. Learn about the visionary's early artistic development and his deep connection with Barcelona. Continue to El Born for a guided walk of one of the city's most emblematic neighborhoods. Meander along this vibrant, eclectic cultural hub to the bourgeois Calle de Montcada, a once-noble street, to admire the 12th-century mansions now housing art museums and galleries.

Tapas Experience. While exploring El Born, join a fun lunch experience, stopping at three tapas bars to sample a variety of delectable tapas small plates with Spanish wine, while learning about Barcelona's culinary traditions.



Free Time: The remainder of the day is yours to explore, including dinner on your own.

Day 7 | Barcelona

Palau de la Música Catalana. This morning, take an inside tour of this breathtaking world treasure of Catalan Modernism. Marvel at the sheer grandeur of the stunning, soaring ornate ceilings and columns, massive organ and spectacular skylight portraying the sun.

Free Time: Venture out to explore at leisure, including lunch, before rejoining the group.

Parc Gűell. Later, set out on a guided visit to Gaudí's playful and surreal Parc Güell, which showcases the modernist's distinctive style of blending nature, architecture and art. In this whimsical green space, stroll along organic, winding pathways, past undulating walls and railings and over stone bridges to appreciate the sense of fluidity and harmony. Marvel at Gaudí's imaginative structures and use of the





trencadis technique of broken ceramic tiles. See the El Drac sculpture and fountain, the grand Hypostyle Hall, with its 86 tree trunk columns and the 360-foot curved serpentine bench, adorned with an intricate pattern of colorful mosaic tiles, in the Nature Square. Enjoy dinner together at a local restaurant.

Day 8 | Barcelona

Telective | Monserrat & the Penedès Wine Region. Travel to the monastery at Montserrat to admire the stunning views from atop the mountainside and visit the basilica to see the Black Madonna statue. Continue to Penedès, Catalonia's premier wine region, known for its famous Cava sparkling wine. Savor lunch and a wine tasting here, then return to Barcelona.

Free Time: You may opt out of the Elective Activity and spend the entire day at leisure! Celebrate your amazing Barcelona adventure at this evening's Farewell Reception.

Day 9 | Return to home city

After breakfast, check out of the hotel.

Transfer to the airport for the return flight to your gateway city.






