Day 5: Berkeley Plantation; Virginia State Capitol (Breakfast, Lunch) *Overnight Staunton, VA*

Day 6: The Greenbrier Bunker Tour; Continue to Columbus (Breakfast)

## Day-by-Day in Detail

Wednesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> - Today, travel from Ohio to Charlottesville, VA and check-in for a one-night stay. Dinner will be on your own at a nearby restaurant.

Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> - Following breakfast, visit Thomas Jefferson's Monticello. This mountain top home is a remarkable integration of classical architecture & modern innovation. Enjoy a guided highlights tour with time after to explore the grounds on your own. Later, a delicious lunch awaits at Historic Michie Tavern, one of the oldest homesteads remaining in Virginia. After, continue to Williamsburg and check-in to your accommodations for the next three nights. Dinner tonight is hosted at a local restaurant.

Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup> - Enjoy breakfast before meeting with your local Historic Triangle guide and set out for Jamestown Settlement. There, enjoy a guided tour of this re-creation of the Jamestown landing site, as well as a Powhatan Village, all with costumed docents. Lunch can be enjoyed at your leisure at the Café before departing for Yorktown. Visit the American Revolution Museum with a guided tour, followed by free time to explore on your own. Then, continue to Yorktown's waterfront for an early dinner before boarding a sunset cruise on the Schooner Alliance. Discover the tranquility of cruising the York River onboard a stunning vessel, powered only by the wind in our sails.

Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup> - After breakfast, meet a costumed guide for a detailed walking tour of Colonial Williamsburg. Highlights include the Capitol, where Virginia patriots developed principles of self-government, individual liberty, & responsible leadership and the Governor's Palace, which reflects the period of Lord Dunmore's residence, the last English governor of the Virginia Colony. *Please Note: The tour will last approximately 3hrs and includes significant walking & standing along unpaved roadways & wooden sidewalks, as well as a few staircases in the Capitol & Governor's Palace.* Following the tour, you will have ample time to explore, shop and enjoy lunch on your own. Return to the hotel this afternoon to rest & refresh, before returning to Colonial Williamsburg for additional free time & to enjoy a delicious dinner at one of the many historical restaurants. We will also offer an optional opportunity to join a candle-lit walking tour of the *haunted* side of Colonial Williamsburg (\$29/person) before returning to the hotel for the evening.

Sunday, June 7<sup>th</sup> - Following breakfast & hotel check-out, visit Berkeley Plantation for a guided tour. Step back in time to a bygone era & experience a genteel 18<sup>th</sup>-Century lifestyle. Their history begins in 1619 when settlers observed the first official Thanksgiving in America. Enjoy a boxed lunch on our way to Richmond to visit the Virginia State Capitol Building, home of the Virginia General Assembly (North America's oldest elected legislative body) & the only statue of George Washington, which was commissioned during his lifetime. Later, continue to Staunton, VA for an overnight stay & dinner on your own.

Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup> - After breakfast, continue to the Greenbrier Resort. Upon arrival, experience a group tour of the resort's declassified bunker complex. Carved deep into the mountainside, the bunker was an emergency Cold War fallout shelter & once a top-secret U.S. government relocation facility for Congress. Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the property, shop, or even try your luck at the casino. A stop for lunch will be made on the way back to Columbus, where you will arrive early this evening.



## Terms & Conditions

**Deposit and Final Payment:** A deposit of \$500 per person (plus applicable insurance premium *see below*) is due upon booking to secure your reservation. Final payment is due on or before March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

- Level 2 - Moderate: A blend of longer & shorter touring days with average physical activity. In addition to the above, travelers should also expect walking tours at longer distances, sometimes over uneven surfaces, including stairs, &/or periods of standing.
