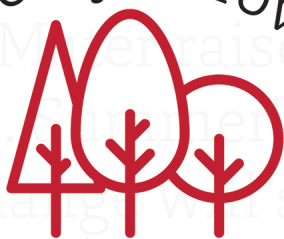

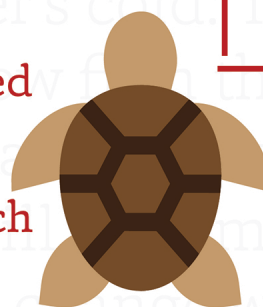

The Illibuck Trophy is passed to the winner Ohio State vs Illinois with each score inscribed on its back

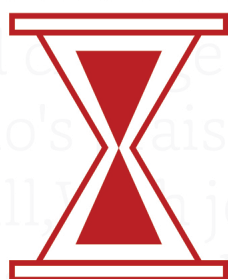

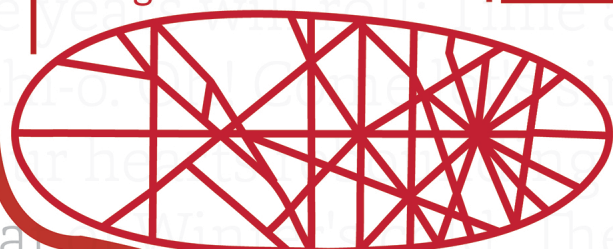
